

SPECIAL MEETING.-7th SEPTEMBER 1914.

A Special Meeting of the Wexford County Council, was held in the Co. Council Chamber, Courthouse, Wexford, on 7th September 1914.

Present:- Mr C. H. Peacecke, (Vice Chairman) Presiding.

The Secretary, County Surveyor, and Mr R. W. Elgee, Solicitor to the Council, were also in attendance.

Sealing Mortgage with National Bank.

On the motion of the Chairman, seconded by Mr Kehee, the following resolution was adopted:-

"That the Seal of the Council be attached to a Mortgage to the National Bank Ltd., to secure the sum of £4375, to be borrowed from said Bank in pursuance of the Consent of the Local Government Board dated 16th July 1914, said loan being for the purpose of Steamrolling roads in the Enniscorthy and new Ross Rural Districts of the County, and to be repaid by five equal instalments spread over a period of five years as in said consent mentioned together with Interest on the amount for the time being due at £3 % per annum."

Signing Advice Notes.

On the motion of the Chairman, seconded by Mr Kehee, the following recommendation was agreed to:-

"That Treasurer's Advice Note for £32. 15/- representing one month's salary to Veterinary Inspectors etc., under Tuberculosis (Ireland) Order and which will bring payments up to 30th June be signed by the Council."

Receiptment Subsidiary A/C.,

On the motion of Mr Kehee, seconded by Mr Cowman, the following recommendation was agreed to:-

"That a sum of £4086. 9. 11d spent out of Subsidiary A/C, on behalf of Loans Account during the half-year, be transferred from Loans Account to Subsidiary Account in order to receipt the latter Account."
