Minutes of Meeting of Sheep Dipping Committee,
Held in the Council Chamber, County Hall,
On Tuesday, 4th August, 1987 at 11.00 a.m.

ATTENDANCE:

MINUTES:

On the proposal of Councillor Joe Murphy, seconded by
Councillor Leo Carty, the Minutes of the Meeting of the
Committee held on 19th September, 1986 were adopted and signed
by the Chairman.

REPORT ON 1986 SHEEP DIPPING SEASON:

Mr. Niall McDonnell outlined for the Committee the
number of sheep dipped during the season which was 260,000 and
gave an account of the receipts and expenditure on sheep dipping
for the season.

Having regard to the number of sheep dipped in 1986 and
the unfair distribution of sheep in the different sheep dipping
areas, it was recommended, on the proposal of Councillor
J. Murphy, seconded by Councillor J. Bolger, that the areas be
re-organised to allow a fair distribution of sheep and that each
Inspector be responsible for dipping approximately 20,000 sheep.

SHEEP DIPPING REGULATIONS 1987:

The Committee discussed the expenses for 1986 and agreed
that the charges for 1987 would have to be revised to take
account of the increased cost of dip and remuneration of Sheep
Dipping Inspectors.

The Sheep Dipping Season 1987 will commence on
21st September, 1987 and will end on 13th November, 1987.
Sheep owners must be in possession of Dipping Certificates for
their sheep at all times during the year except in the case of
sheep born between any two consecutive different periods.

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The dipping charges for 1987 were fixed as follows:

40p per sheep dipped in a public bath;
20p per sheep dipped in a private bath.

The owner of a private bath or members of a co-operative bath dipping in their own bath, shall be charged 13p per sheep dipped.

FILLING OF VACANCY FOR SHEEP DIPPING INSPECTOR:


The Committee recommended that the vacancy arising following the appointment of Mr. Philip Doyle as Sheep Dipping Supervisor be advertised and filled.

REPRESENTATION AT ALL-IRELAND SHEEP DIPPING COMMITTEE:

The Committee agreed that Councillor Leo Carty and either J. Bolger or J. Murphy will attend the next meeting of the All-Ireland Sheep Dipping Committee to be held in the offices of Kilkenny County Council, John's Green, Kilkenny, on the 25th September, 1987 commencing at 2.30 p.m.


