Minutes:

On the proposal of Cllr. Leo Carthy, seconded by Cllr. Tommy Carr, the minutes of the meeting held on 28th July, 1994 were adopted and signed by the Chairman.

Correspondence:

The Members discussed a letter received from the Irish Naturists Association in relation to the provision of the clothing optional beaches in Co. Wexford. On the proposal of Cllr. Avril Doyle, seconded by Cllr. Helen Corish-Wylde, the committee requested details of the Council's response to the letter of 1st July, 1994.

Planning Reports:

The Committee discussed a number of planning applications refusals or interest with the Planning Officer.

Engineers Reports:

The members discussed a number of items requiring investigation with the Engineering staff.

Housing Reports:

The committee agreed to defer consideration of the Housing Officers Report and Housing Construction Programme for 1995 until a further meeting.

Meeting - Tighmon Tidy Towns Committee

Cllr. Padge Reck, Chairman welcomed the Tighmon Tidy Towns Committee and introduced the members and officials of the Council. The Tidy Towns Committee members included Sam Deacon, Chairman; Sean Sinnot, Secretary; Seamus Murphy; Tom O'Donnell; Josie McGuirke; Auala Carr and Frank O'Connor.

On behalf of the Tidy Towns Committee, Mr. Sam Deacon presented a report and display outlining the History of Tighmon and a forty point plan recommending improvements and repairs to clean up the village and bring it back to its former glory. Mr. Deacon requested the assistance of Wexford County Council in carrying out some of the repairs and improvements outlined in the report.

Mr. Pat Walshe, Executive Engineer, explained to the meeting that the Council had no funds available for the remainder of 1994 to carry out any improvement works in the roads areas. However, he agreed to meet the committee and Macra to discuss the provision of fencing at Ross Road and other matters which required minor improvements and repairs.

Mr. Niall McDonnell, Housing Officer, explained that the Council would consider the provision of four houses for Senior Citizens opposite the Health Centre as part of the 1995 Housing allocation. If the Council was not in a position to provide these houses, it would seek additional means to provide housing. The Council would also investigate the possibility of providing Housing in an area of open space at the old Tennis Court which had become derelict and which was not a suitable play area for children.


With regard to the unauthorised scrap yard at Taghmon, Mr. Peadar Mcbald undertook to check the current position following the serving of an enforcement notice on the owners. Mr. Paul Wilson informed the Committee that the Council was working on resolving the problem with the water supply to Taghmon. Mr. Brian White, Senior Staff Officer, Environment Section outlined the Councils' policy on providing skips to clean up areas in the County which was normally carried out for a short period in May each year. This was to ensure the most cost effective and efficient method of cleaning areas in conjunction with local communities and organisations. However, he undertook to investigate the possibility of providing assistance on clearing the refuse dumped at Alley Road.

The committee were also advised to apply for grant aid under the Local Improvement Scheme and Amenity Grant Scheme in 1995 for financial assistance with local improvements.

Cllr. Podge Reck, Chairman, thanked the committee for attending the meeting.
